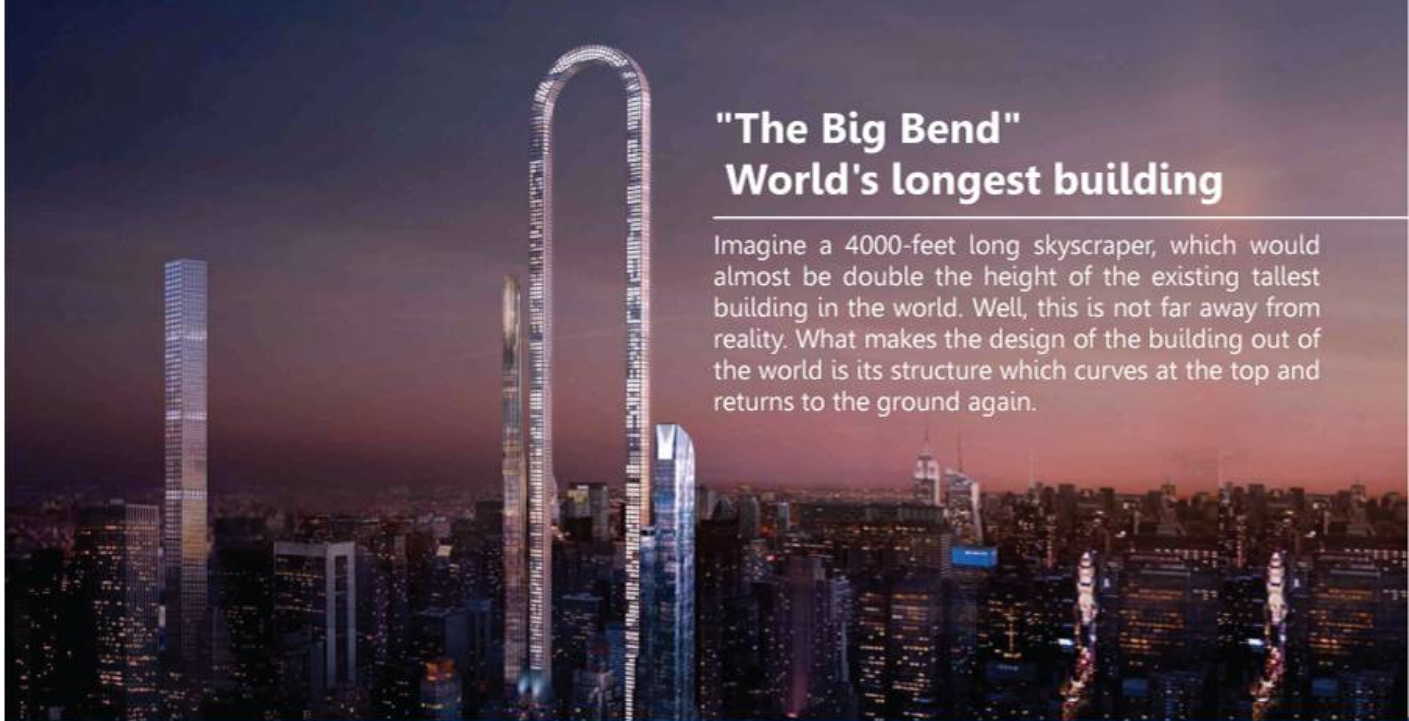
Global investors eye opportunities in Indian real estate sector
